## Capital Campaign Cabinet Report – C. Tiedemann, Co-Chair

The Capital Campaign Cabinet (CCC) met on Thursday, April 8, 2021. Key outcomes of that meeting included:

- Review of the prospect list, each CCC member is volunteering to engage 3 to 5 prospects with support from the FEF administration.
- Plans are underway to bring closure to the Light the Midway campaign at the upcoming virtual Honourary Chief Factor's Breakfast. Councilors Cartmell and Pacquette will approach Mayor Iveson regarding whether he would be willing to give a personal endorsement of the Campaign and leverage his social media contacts to support as well.
- The possibility of having either an "onsite" or "virtual" tour of the redeveloped Park prior to the official opening for "prime" donors.
- The potential of having the Alberta Medical Association, the Alberta Dental Association and the Alberta Pharmacist's Association fund and support the development of historic displays of their respective professions at the Park was discussed.
